The single tender document procedure is followed. The tenders are required to submit Electronic Bid Document-I (Technical Bid) along with technical details of their capability to undertake the tender (as detailed in Bid document) and Electronic Bid Document-II (Financial bid) in Karnataka Public procurement portal only.

The Electronic Bid Document-II (Financial bid) of the technically qualified bidders will only be opened in Karnataka Public procurement portal. The tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria in the bid document to qualify for the award of work .Table showing the details of work put to tender is as under;

- 3.1 All tenderers shall provide the requested information accurately and in sufficient detail in Section 3: Form of Tender and Qualification information.
- 3.2 To qualify for award of this contract, each tenderer in its name should have in the last five years i.e. 2021-22 to 2025-2026)
 - a) The intending bidder should have satisfactorily completed as a prime contractor with at least one similar type of work like “**Operation and maintenance of DWSS/LIS/TFS**” work of value not less than 50% of the amount put to tender in **Rs.10.29 lakhs** at least one year during preceding five years. (For which certificate should be obtained from the competent authority not below the rank of Executive Engineer. (Should be scanned and enclosed) (Additional weight age @ 10% for each year will be given to bring it to 2026-27 price level)

(b) The intending bidder should have achieved in at least two Financial years a minimum financial Turnover of value an average annual financial turnover of value not less than **Rs.20.59 lakhs (In all classes of Civil Engineering works only)** in preceding 5 years from 2021-2022 to 2025-26. Audited balance sheet certified by the chartered accountant should be enclosed. (Additional weight age @ 10% for each year will be given for turn over to bring it to 2025-26) Audited balance sheet certified by practicing Chartered cc along with UDIN shall be furnished. 3.3 Eligible Tenderers will be qualified only if their available tender capacity is more than the total tender value. The available tender capacity will be calculated as under:

3.4 All tenderers shall provide the requested information accurately and in sufficient detail in Section 3: Form of Tender and Qualification information.

3.5 To qualify for award of this contract, each tenderer in its name should have in the last five years i.e. 2021-22 to 2025-2026)

b) The intending bidder should have satisfactorily completed as a prime contractor with at least one similar type of work like “**Any Construction work**” of value not less than 25% of the amount put to tender in **Rs.6.15 lakhs** at least one year during preceding five years. (For which certificate should be obtained from the competent authority not below the rank of Executive Engineer. (Should be scanned and enclosed) (Additional weight age @ 10% for each year will be given to bring it to 2026-27 price level)

(b) The intending bidder should have achieved in at least **one** Financial years a minimum financial Turnover of value an average annual financial turnover of value not less than **Rs.24.60 lakhs (In all classes of Civil Engineering works only)** in preceding 5 years from 2021-2022 to 2025-26. Audited balance sheet certified by the chartered accountant should be enclosed. (Additional weight age @ 10% for each year will be given for turn over to bring it to 2025-26) Audited balance sheet certified by practicing Chartered cc along with UDIN shall be furnished. Audited balance sheets & Turnover certificate mentioning UDIN number should be mandatorily uploaded along with tender, failing which tender will be liable for rejection

3.6 Eligible Tenderers will be qualified only if their available tender capacity is more than the total tender value. The available tender capacity will be calculated as under:

Assessed available tender capacity = (A*N*5.00 - B)
Where

A = Maximum value of Civil Engineering works executed in any one year during the last five years (updated to 2026-27 price level) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress

N = Number of years prescribed for completion of the works for which Tenders are invited.
B = Value, at 2026-27 price level, of existing commitments and on-going works to be complete during the next years. (period of completion of works for which tenders are invited)

Note: The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Employer in charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent

3.4 Even though the Tenderers meet the above criteria they are subject to be disqualified if they have

- a) Made misleading or false representation in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements and / or
- b) Record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history or financial failure etc., and / or
- c) Participated in the previous tender for the same work and had quoted unreasonably high tender prices and could not furnish rational justification.
- d) If the contractor is involved in multiple projects, the value of ongoing works in subtracted from his bid capacity. Since his assets will be engaged with other work also. Not disclosing the ongoing works, contractors is involved in, amounts to misrepresentation of facts. Hence fraudulent practise under clause 113 of KPWD code.

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

Electronic Document-I (Technical Bid) shall contain the following documents

1. The intending bidder should furnish the copy of the registration certificate issued by KPWD IV and above for Civil contractor.
2. The bidder must compulsorily furnish registered valid **Electrical license of class II and above (for the indent no 5083,5084,5085,5086 and 5087)**
3. The bidder must compulsorily furnish valid caste and domicile certificate for mentioned reserved works above.
4. The Intending bidder are advised to visit the site of work and also access the tender documents well in advance & conditional tenders will not be accepted.
5. The bidder should furnish Annual turn over certificate indicating turnover of past five years with compulsory UDIN Number.
6. The Tender validity will be **90** days .
7. The requisite earnest money deposit (EMD) through online only with validity of **45 days beyond the validity of tender** from the date of closing of the tender. Earnest money deposit (EMD) can also be submitted as per circular no: FD5 Exp-12/2023 dt: 10.02.2023 in the form of "e-Bank guarantee"
8. The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender, and the employer will in no case be responsible and liable for those costs.
9. The TENDER PROCEEDING FEE will not be refunded.

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10. The employer is not responsible for any delay in accessing Karnataka public procurement Portal.
 11. All the formats prescribed in the bid document shall be filled by the bidders in a complete manner. Incomplete formats may constitute sufficient reason at the discretion of CNL for rejection of the bid.
 12. All scanned documents to be uploaded shall be in original and the Executive Engineer will verify the original documents at any stage before recommending for approval. Bidders should produce their original documents for verification during office hours related to uploaded documents in Karnataka public procurement portal immediately after opening of Electronic Bid Document-I (Technical Bid).
 13. Further particulars, if any, required by the bidders can be obtained from the office of the Executive Engineer, HLBC, CNL Turuvekere, during office hours on all working days. It may be noted that if any of the calendar of any event mentioned above happen to be General Holiday / Declared holiday, the next working day will hold good for the respective events.
 14. The intending contractors should note that, it's the responsibility of the contractor to obtain the necessary approvals & permissions from the concerned departments during execution at no extra cost to the Nigam and no claims whatsoever relating would be entertained.
 15. The bid validity will be 90 days from date of closing of tenders.
 16. Performance security:-
 1. Within 20 days of receipt of the letter of acceptance, successful tenderer shall deliver to the employer a security deposit for an amount equivalent to 5.00% of the contract price & additional performance security for unbalanced tenders if quoted below in accordance with the clause 29.1 of ITT and clause 43 of the conditions of the contract.
 2. The successful bidder should execute work agreement within 20 days from the date of issue of Letter of Acceptance, failing which his tender will be cancelled & EMD will be forfeited.
 3. FSD can also be submitted as per GO : FD-12/2023 Dated :15-05-2023
 17. Defect liability period will be **1 Year** from the date of completion. **for the indent no 5083,5084,5085,5086 and 5087**
 18. Tenderers shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by the Government of Karnataka
 19. The Tenderer should furnish the Name of the individual / firm/ Company with address & telephone number with place of registration, year of incorporation etc.
 20. The application made by the firm / company shall be signed by a person holding the power of attorney, in which case the Tenderer should furnish a copy of power of attorney signed by the board of directors in Karnataka public procurement portal along with their bid
 21. The scanned signature of the bidders / authorized representatives of the bidders shall be attached while uploading the Bid document.
 22. Necessary certificates should be signed by an officer not below the rank of the Executive Engineer or equivalent competent authority
 23. The intending Bidder/firm/company should furnish list of man power available with him for taking up above work.
 24. The intending Bidder/firm/company shall provide accurate information on the related form about any litigation or arbitration resulting from contracts completed or on going under its execution over the last five years. The consisting history of awards against the tenderer may result in failure of the application.
 25. Tenderer should furnish a copy of the Income Tax Return for the preceding five financial year (2021-22 to 2025-26)

26. The intending Bidder/firm/company shall provide the audited balance sheets or other financial statements acceptable to the employer for the last five years (2021-22 to 2025-26) and must demonstrate the current soundness of the applicant's financial position and indicate its prospective long term profitability. If deemed necessary the employer shall have the authority to make enquiries with the applicants bankers.
27. The Tenderer should furnish a valid copy of GST Registration Certificate
28. Employees Provident Fund Registration Certificate, (For all indents above) and if the bidder has less than 20 labours he has to submit self-certified labour details (For indents 5085,5086,5087,5147,5146,5145,5144,5143,5142,5141 and 5186) failing which their tenders will be disqualified.
 - a) In respect of Contractors who are not registered with the EPF (Employees Provident Fund) authorities, the contractors should produce an undertaking that he shall within 7 days of the close of every month submit to the Executive Engineer, HLBC Division CNNL Turuvekere, a statement showing the recoveries of contributions in respect of employees employed are through in and shall also furnish under the provision of the scheme to the commissioner, EPF.
 - b) However, having given an undertaking to this effect if the contractor does not furnish the information, the Nigama will deduct the necessary amount from the amount due from the contractor. Notwithstanding the above, the contractor will be liable for any consequential penalty /damages levied by the EPF authorities.
29. The intending bidders are advised to visit the site of work before attending the pre- bid meeting and also before submitting the tenders.
30. Royalty Recovery from the contractors bill will be made as per Government Circular Dt:-24.01.2025 & further any Orders/Circulars issued by Government of Karnataka from time to time
31. The bidder should follow the instructions issued in the Circular dated: 07-11-2023 of Mines and Geology Department regarding Procurement of materials from the licensed Mines Contractor. Any Violations in this regard the action will be taken as per the Circular.
32. In the case of the death of the contractor after executing the agreement / commencement of the work, his legal heir, if is an eligible registered contractor and is willing can execute and complete the work at the accepted tender rates irrespective of the cost of the work
33. The rates quoted by the contractor must be Excluding GST. The contractor is also required to pay quarry Fees, Royalties, Octroi Dues levied by the state Government or any Local body or an authority and ground rent, if any, charged by the Executive Engineer for stacking materials. No Extra Payment on this account will be made to the contractor.
34. GST will be deducted as per the prevailing Govt Orders from time to time
35. Materials like Pipes, steel, cement etc., required for the work shall be procured by the Contractor themselves and should get the same tested by the quality control authority of CNNL before use in this work
36. The work includes all lead and lift / delift and work shall be carried out as per instruction of engineer-in-charge of the work. And all the specification as per Indian road congress and all relevant Indian codes. The rate for the specifications in the Schedule-B includes all lead and lift, irrespective of distance and height. No extra claim will be entertained for additional lead and lifts.
37. Building and other construction workers welfare cess:

The contractor shall subscribe 1.00% of gross amount of each bill payable to him in respect of contract to the building and other construction workers welfare cess as per GO No: LD 300 LET 2006, Bangalore, dated: 18-01-2007. The amount of subscription will be recovered out of payable amount to him in each bill. This component is deemed to have been included in the quoted rate / Item rate.

38. Successful Bidder should submit the PERT Chart at the time of Execution of Agreement & should adhere to the accepted action plan submitted by him under any circumstances without linking to the pending payment of the work.
39. Tendering by the joint venture is not allowed
40. The intending bidders shall visit the site, identify the quarries, ascertain availability for the quantity and quality of the materials required for the work and shall quote his rates accordingly. No extra claim whatsoever will be entertained in this regard.
