**General Conditions: -**

- 1) Tenders from joint ventures are not acceptable.
- 2) The contractor shall quote item wise rates in the tender and the same will hold good till the works are completed. The rates should include provision for payment of all taxes **(excluding 18% GST)**, Royalty or any other statutory taxes due to the Corporation/Government, EPF/ESI on wages of labours etc. The rates quoted should be inclusive of all leads and lifts for materials etc. The bidder should visit the work spot at his own cost before quoting his rates to assess the quantities and nature of work shown in the schedule. **The amount/rate put to tender are exclusive of 18% GST and the bidders have to quote the rates excluding 18% GST. The GST of 18% will be added separately in comparative statement, DWA.**
- 3) As per the Karnataka Minor Mineral concession Rules-1964, it is mandatory to submit the Mineral Dispatch Permits (MDPs) issued by the competent authority, along with the bills. If not, penalty will be levied as per the prevailing clauses.
- 4) No materials will be supplied departmentally. The bidder has to make their own arrangement for procurement of required materials, arranging electricity, water supply etc. to complete the work.
- 5) The rates/prices quoted by the bidder are firm for the duration of the contract.
- 6) Bid shall remain valid for a period of **90 days** from the date of the opening of technical bid.
- 7) Conditional bid is liable for rejection without assigning any reasons there off.
- 8) The successful bidder shall bind himself to abide by the rules and specifications in force & he should produce all the original certificates/documents for verification wherever required which are scanned at the time of quoting the tender and shall execute the necessary agreement on Non judicial stamp paper of prescribed amount **within ten days** from the date of intimation of acceptance of his /their bid, failing which his /their bid will be cancelled unconditionally, and his /their earnest money deposit will be forfeited.
- 9) Quantities given in the notification and schedule are approximate and are liable to increase or decrease.
- 10) The work should not be sub-let.
- 11) On acceptance of the successful bidders, the earnest money deposit paid by the other unsuccessful bidders will be refunded only after the agreement of the work executed by the successful bidder.

- 12) The Contractor shall pay liquidated damages to the Employer at the rate 0.1% of the contract price per day stated in the Contract Data for each day that the Completion Date is later than the Intended Completion Date. The total amount of liquidated damages shall not exceed 10 % of the final contract price as defined in the Contract Data. The Employer may deduct liquidated damages from payments due to the Contractor. Payment of liquidated damages does not affect the Contractor's liabilities.
- 13) The bidder has to pay compensation of the disabled or deceased workmen under him for any injury or death caused during the execution of works, failing which the necessary amount will be deducted from the bills and paid to the injured or deceased.
- 14) Time is the essence of contract and the extension to the stipulated period of completion will not be entertained. The bidder has to arrange sufficient men, machinery & materials so that, the work can be completed within the stipulated period.
- 15) All duties, taxes, 18% GST, cess, payment towards other levies and statutory payments payable by the contractor under the contract or any other claims shall be included in the rates quoted by the tenderer. In addition to the statutory taxes and levies, 1% (one percent) of the bill amount will be deducted from the contractor's bills towards Construction Workers welfare Cess as per Government Order dated: 18-1-2007.
- 16) It is the responsibility of the accepted tenderer who executes the work to obtain Water, Power supply from KPTCL/local bodies/OTHER Govt authorities' clearance from the Government Electrical Inspectorate as the case may be. Further it is the responsibility of the accepted tenderer to obtain all permissions from concerned departments by remitting necessary fees for executing the work. It is the responsibility of the accepted tenderer to coordinate with other major agencies who are already working in the project to obtain any necessary power or water connections and any other related permission from concerned departments for execution of the work.
- 17) KPTCL reserves the right to reject or accept any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons there for.
