On behalf of the Managing Director, CNNL, Bengaluru, the Executive Engineer, CNNL, Hemavathy Canal Division, Tumakuru the undersigned invites tenders on Item Rate basis using **KW-1 & KW-2** standard conditions from eligible contractors for the work as detailed in table below.

The two Tender Document procedure is followed. The tenders are required to submit Technical Bid containing EMD with technical details of their capability to undertake the tender (as detailed in Bid document) and financial bid in KPPP only.

The Financial bid of the technically qualified bidders will only be opened in KPPP. The tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria in the bid document to qualify for the award of work.

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Special note: If the rate(s) quoted by Tenderer for any item(s) of work is / are below the estimated rates of the department then the contractor shall furnish an additional performance security for an amount equivalent to difference between the cost as per quoted rate and the estimated rates. In case of contractor quoting rate above 125% of the estimated rates, then the amount over and above 125% will be withheld during the progress of work. Additional performance security & fixed secured deposit as per KW rules should be given at the time of execution of the agreement.

1.1 Qualifying Conditions:- (KW-1 & KW-2 Works)

1. Bidder should be registered KPWD Contractor in the required class as stated in the above table.
2. Reserved bidders should upload caste certificate along with their bids failing which their tenders will be disqualified.
3. Reserved bidder should upload valid domicile certificate along with their bids stating domicile of state of Karnataka for more than 10 years failing which their tenders will be disqualified. (Any other certificates other than domicile certificate will not be considered).
4. Valid GST registration certificate should be uploaded.
5. Employees provident fund (EPF) registration certificate should be uploaded, & if the bidder who is not registered with EPF authorities should upload the latest EPF exemption certificate, addressed to the undersigned below.
6. The Rates Quoted by The Bidders Shall be Exclusive Of GST.
7. The Joint Venture is not Acceptable.

2. GENERAL CONDITIONS TO TENDERERS :- (KW-1 & KW-2 Works)

The intending bidder should furnish the copy of the certificate of registration issued by state/ central Govt.

The Intending bidders / tenderers are advised to visit the site of work and also access the tender documents well in advance.

Conditional tenders will not be accepted.

The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender, and the employer will in no case be responsible and liable for those costs.

The TENDER PROCESSING FEE will not be refunded.

The employer is not responsible for any delay in accessing KPPP Portal.

All the formats prescribed in the bid document shall be filled by the bidders in a complete manner. Incomplete formats may constitute sufficient reason at the discretion of CNNL for rejection of the bid.

All scanned documents to be uploaded shall be in original and the Executive Engineer will verify the original documents at any stage before recommending for approval. Bidders should produce their original documents for verification during office hours related to uploaded documents in e-portal immediately after opening of technical Bid.

Further particulars, if any, required by the bidders can be had from the office of the Executive Engineer, H.C. Division, Tumkur during office hours on all working days. It may be noted that if any of the calendar of any event mentioned above happen to be General Holiday / Declared holiday, the next working day will hold good for the respective events.

1. The intending bidders should note that, if any of the lands (either in part/parts or in whole) required for the work is not yet acquired by the Nigama, it shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder to take possession of such land by consent of the owners before commencement of work at no extra cost to the Nigam and no claims whatsoever relating to non-availability of land would be entertained.

Defect liability period will be **Six Months** from the date of completion of the entire work.

2. The Tenderer should furnish the Name of the individual /firm/ Company with address and Contact number with place of registration, year of incorporation etc.,

3. The application made by the firm / company shall be signed by a person holding the power of attorney, in which case the Tenderer should furnish a copy of power of attorney signed by the board of directors in e-portal along with their bid.

4. The scanned signature of the bidders / authorized representatives of the bidders shall be attached while uploading the Bid document.

5. Necessary certificates should be signed by an officer not below the rank of the Executive Engineer or equivalent competent authority and should be countersigned by the superior officer not below the rank of Superintending Engineer or equivalent competent authority.

6. The intending Bidder/firm/company should furnish list of man power available with him for taking up above work.

7. The intending Bidder/firm/company shall provide accurate information on the related form about any litigation or Arbitration resulting from contracts completed or ongoing under its execution over the last five years. The consisting history of awards against the tenderer may result in failure of the application.

8. Tenderer should furnish a copy of the Income Tax Return for the preceding five financial year (2021-22 to 2025-26)

9. The intending Bidder/firm/company shall provide the audited balance sheets or other financial statements acceptable to the employer for the last five years (2021-22 to 2025-26) and must demonstrate the current soundness of the applicant's financial position and indicate its prospective long term profitability. If deemed necessary the employer shall have the authority to make enquiries with the applicants bankers.

10. The Tenderer should furnish a valid copy of GST Registration Certificate along with updated GST clearance copies

11. Employees provident fund registration certificate along with copy of recent paid challan is to be furnished.

- (i) Employees Provident fund Registration Certificate
- a) **In respect of Contractors who are not registered with the EPF** (Employees Provident Fund) authorities, the contractors should produce an undertaking that he shall within 7 days of the close of every month submit to the Executive Engineer, Hemavathy canal division Tumakuru, a statement showing the recoveries of contributions in respect of employees employed by him and shall also furnish under the provision of the scheme to the commissioner, EPF.
- b) However, having given an undertaking to this effect if the contractor does not furnish the information, the Nigama will deduct the necessary amount from the amount due from the contractor. Notwithstanding the above, the contractor will be liable for any consequential penalty /damages levied by the EPF authorities.
24. The intending bidders are advised to visit the site of work before attending the pre- bid meeting and also before submitting the tenders.
25. Royalty Recovery from the contractors bill will be made as per Government Circular Dt:-24.01.2025 & further any Orders/Circulars issued by Government of Karnataka from time to time.
26. The Bidder should follow the Instructions issued in the Circular at 07-11-2023 of the Mines & geology Department regarding Procurement of Material from the Licenced Mines contractors any violation in this regard action will be taken as per the circular.
27. **The rates quoted by the contractor must be excluding GST.** The contractor is also required to pay quarry Fees, Royalties, Octroi Dues levied by the state Government or any Local body or an authority and ground rent, if any, charged by the Executive Engineer for stacking materials. No Extra Payment on this account will be made to the contractor.
28. Applicable GST will be paid separately & GST will be deducted as per the prevailing Govt Orders from time to time.
29. Increase in GST shall not be paid in extended period of contract for which the contractor alone is responsible for delay as determined by the authority while granting the extension of time.
30. Materials required for the work shall be procured by the Contractor themselves and should get the same tested by the quality control authority of CNNL before use in this work.
30. The work includes all lead and lift /de lift and work shall be carried out as per instruction of engineer-in-charge of the work. And all the specification as per Indian road congress and all relevant Indian codes. The rate for the specifications in the Schedule-B includes all lead and lift, irrespective of distance and height. no extra claim will be entertained for additional lead and lifts.
31. If CNNL wishes to engage third party consultants for quality control assessment, apart from the CNNL quality control and field tests, the contractor should co-operate with both Quality control authorities and the third party.
- 32. Performance security:-**
1. Within 20 days of receipt of the letter of acceptance, successful tenderer shall deliver to the employer a security deposit in any of the forms like FDR/TDR/Bank Guarantee for an amount equivalent to 5.00% of the contract price plus additional security for unbalanced tenders.
 2. Successful bidder should execute work agreement within 20 days from the date of issue of Letter of acceptance, failing which his tender will be cancelled on Risk & Cost basis
 3. If the rate (s) quoted by Tenderer for any item (s) of work is / are above 125% of the estimated rates, then the amount over and above 125% will be withheld during the progress of work.
 4. Security deposit for SC/ST/CAT (II)A Contractors for an amount equivalent to 5.00% of contract price shall be deducted in every running bill.

34. Reservation in tenders for SC/ST Contractors is provided as per Government Order No: FD 611 EXP-12/2023, Bangalore Dated: 03.02.2024 & For CAT-1/CAT-2(A) Contractors is provided as per Government Order No: FD 506 EXP- 12/2024, Bangalore Dated: 20.08.2024
35. Building and other construction workers welfare cess: The contractor shall subscribe 1.00% of gross amount of each bill payable to him in respect of contract to the building and other construction workers welfare cess as per GO No: LD 300 LET 2006, Bangalore, dated: 18-01-2007. The amount of subscription will be recovered out of payable amount to him in each bill. This component is deemed to have been included in the quoted rate / Item rate .
36. Tendering by the joint venture will not be permitted.
37. Sub leasing /sub contracting in any form is prohibited. Bids of bidders with track record of Sub leasing / subcontracting are liable for rejection
38. The quarries considered are for the estimate purpose only. The intending bidders shall visit the site, identify the quarries, ascertain availability for the quantity and quality of the materials required for the work and shall quote his rates accordingly. No extra claim whatsoever will be entertained in this regard.
39. All precautions should be taken by the contractor so that there are no damages to such public/private Properties & to avoid any damage to the utilities during excavation as well as utility shifting.
40. Contractor should follow strictly the prevailing rules of labour act.
41. Contractor should adhere to HSE (Health Safety Environment) policy applicable for similar projects.
42. Contractor to that extent should submit HSE document defining all the procedure including the policies before execution of the project.
43. Contractor should take all precautions to ensure that no damage is caused to the existing structures which have been constructed by other agencies during project execution. If any damage is caused, it has to be rectified at his own risk and cost.
44. The intending bidders should inspect & get confirm regarding availability of materials and has to make own arrangements to get the construction materials. There is no extra claims will be entertained from Department.
45. Uploading of NSIC Certificate or Other certificate for relaxation of EMD Payment is not accepted as per government Order Dated 26.03.2019.
46. CNL reserves the right of rejecting all or any of the tenders without assigning any reasons.
47. Typographical errors if any will not be the ground for any claims by the contractor.
48. Tenders shall remain valid for a period not less than ninety days after the deadline date for tender submission & earnest money deposit for the tender shall be valid for 45 days beyond the validity of the tender
49. The undersigned reserves the right to either postpone or to cancel the entire process of tender.
50. As per Karnataka state Government order LD/300/LET/2006 Bangalore dated 01.01.2007 and Government letter no PW/134/BMS/2007 dated 27.07.2007, A Sum amounting to 1% of the bill amount will be deducted towards constructions labour welfare fund.
51. In the case of the death of the contractor after executing the agreement /commencement of the work, his legal heir, if is an eligible registered contractor and willing, can execute and complete the work at the accepted tender rates irrespective of the cost of the work.
52. All safety precautions, warning signs, night illumination, reflectors, deployment of security guards has to be ensured so that no untoward incident happens on Account of negligence or any project activity. Contractor should indemnify the client to that extent.

Achieved in at least Two Financial years for General Category & One Financial Year for Reservation Category, an average (KW-1 & 2) annual financial turnover (in all classes of civil engineering construction works only) of value usually not less than the amount put to tender. Audited balance sheet certified by practicing Chartered Accountant along with UDIN shall be furnished. (Additional weightage @ 10% for each year will be given for turn over to bring it to 2026-27) Audited balance sheets & Turnover certificate mentioning UDIN number should be mandatorily uploaded along with tender, failing which tender will be liable for rejection.




