On behalf of the Managing Director, CNNL, Bengaluru, the Executive Engineer, CNNL, Hemavathy Canal Division, Hebburu the undersigned invites tender on ITEM RATE basis for Emergent work as per Standard Bid Document KW-1 with latest amendments from eligible contractors for the work as detailed in table below.

1. Available Tender bid capacity calculation For Open tenders

1.1 Tenderers who meet the above specified minimum qualifying criteria, will only be qualified, if their available tender capacity is more than the total tender value. The available tender capacity will be calculated as under:

$$\text{Assessed available tender capacity} = (A \times N \times 2.5-B)$$

Where,

A =Maximum value of Civil works executed in any one year during the last five years taking into account the completed as well as works in progress. (Updated to 2026-27 price level)

N =Number of years prescribed for completion of the works for which tenders are invited = N/12 Years

B =Value, at 2026-27 price level, of existing commitments and on-going works to be completed during the next N months. (N=Period of completion of the works for which tenders are invited)

Note: The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Employer in charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent & Audited balance sheets mentioning UDIN number should be mandatorily uploaded along with tender, failing with which tender will be liable for rejection.

2. Available Tender bid capacity calculation For Reserved Tenders

2.1. Tenderers who meet the above specified minimum qualifying criteria, will only be qualified, if their available tender capacity is more than the total tender value. The available tender capacity will be calculated as under:

$$\text{Assessed available tender capacity} = (A \times N \times 5.0 - B)$$

Where,

A =Maximum value of Civil works executed in any one year during the last five years taking into account the completed as well as works in progress. (Updated to 2026-27 price level)

N =Number of years prescribed for completion of the works for which tenders are invited = N/12 Years

B =Value, at 2026-27 price level, of existing commitments and on-going works to be completed during the next N months. (N=Period of completion of the works for which tenders are invited)

Note: The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Employer in charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent & Audited balance sheets mentioning UDIN number should be mandatorily uploaded along with tender, failing with which tender will be liable for rejection.

1.5 GENERAL CONDITIONS TO TENDERERS :-

1. Bidder should be registered KPWD Contractor in the required class.
2. Tendering by the joint venture will not be permitted.
3. The Intending bidders/tenderers are advised to visit the site of work and also access the tender documents well in advance.
4. Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
5. The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender, and the employer will in no case be responsible and liable for those costs.
6. The TENDER PROCEEDING FEE will not be refunded.
7. The requisite Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) through e-cash only; Each tenderer must pay specified full Earnest money Deposit (EMD) in the e-procurement platform only through any of the payment modes such as Credit Card/ Debit Card/ NEFT / OTC.
8. As per Circular No. FD 5 Expenditure-12 -2023 dt: 10-02-2023, the requisite Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) can also be submitted in the form of "e-Bank Guarantee" wherever applicable.
9. The employer is not responsible for any delay in accessing Karnataka public procurement Portal.

10. All the formats prescribed in the bid document shall be filled by the bidders in a complete manner. Incomplete formats may constitute sufficient reason at the discretion of CNNL for rejection of the bid.
11. All scanned documents to be uploaded shall be in original and the Executive Engineer will verify the original documents at any stage before recommending for approval. Bidders should produce their original documents for verification during office hours related to uploaded documents in Karnataka public procurement portal immediately after opening of technical Bid.
12. Further particulars, if any, required by the bidders can be had from the office of the Executive Engineer, H.C.I. Division, Hebburu during office hours on all working days. It may be noted that if any of the calendar of any event mentioned above happen to be General Holiday / Declared holiday, the next working day will hold good for the respective events.
13. The intending bidders should note that, if any of the lands (either in part/parts or in whole) required for the work is not yet acquired by the Nigama, it shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder to take possession of such land by consent of the owners before commencement of work at no extra cost to the Nigam and no claims whatsoever relating to non-availability of land would be entertained.
14. Tenderers shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by the Government of Karnataka.
15. The Tenderer should furnish the Name of the individual / firm/ Company with address and telephone number with place of registration, year of incorporation etc.,
16. The application made by the firm / company shall be signed by a person holding the power of attorney, in which case the Tenderer should furnish a copy of power of attorney signed by the board of directors in Karnataka Public procurement portal along with their bid.
17. The scanned signature of the bidders / authorized representatives of the bidders shall be attached while uploading the Bid document.
18. Necessary certificates should be signed by an officer not below the rank of the Executive Engineer or equivalent competent authority and should be countersigned by the superior officer not below the rank of Superintending Engineer or equivalent competent authority.
19. The intending Bidder/firm/company shall provide accurate information on the related form about any litigation or Arbitration resulting from contracts completed or ongoing under its execution over the last five years. The consisting history of awards against the tendered may result in failure of the application.
20. Tenderer should furnish a copy of the Income Tax Return for any two years (any one year for reserved tenders) in the preceding five financial year (2021-22 to 2025-26).
21. The intending Bidder/firm/company shall provide the audited balance sheets or other financial statements acceptable to the employer for any two years (any one year for reserved tenders) in the last five years (2021-22 to 2025-26) and must demonstrate the current soundness of the applicant's financial position and indicate its prospective long term profitability. If deemed necessary the employer shall have the authority to make enquiries with the applicants bankers.
22. The Tenderer should furnish a valid copy of GST Registration Certificate.
23. The intending bidders are advised to visit the site of work before submitting the tenders.
24. The contractor has to submit MDP compulsorily with respect of utilization of Royalty Payable Materials to the extent of 100%, failing the royalty charges, additional payment on royalty & penalties if any will be recovered from the contractor bills as per the prevailing Government orders.

25. The rates quoted by the contractor must be excluding GST. The contractor is also required to pay quarry Fees, Royalties, Octroi Dues levied by the state Government or any Local body or an authority and ground rent, if any, charged by the Executive Engineer for stacking materials. No Extra Payment on this account will be made to the contractor.
26. Applicable GST will be paid separately & GST (TDS) will be deducted as per the prevailing Government Orders from time to time.
27. Increase in GST shall not be paid in extended period of contract for which the contractor alone is responsible for delay as determined by the authority while granting the extension of time.
28. Materials required for the work shall be procured by the Contractor themselves and should get the same tested by the quality control authority of CNNL before use in this work.
29. The work includes all lead and lift and work shall be carried out as per instruction of engineer-in-charge of the work. And all the specification as per Indian road congress and all relevant Indian codes. The rate for the specifications in the Schedule-B includes all lead and lift, irrespective of distance and height. No extra claim will be entertained for additional lead and lifts.
30. Performance security:-
 1. Within 20 days of receipt of the letter of acceptance, successful tenderer shall deliver to the employer a security deposit for an amount equivalent to 5.00% of the contract price & additional performance security for unbalanced tenders if quoted below in accordance with the clause 25.5 of ITT of the tender document.
 2. As per Circular No. FD 5 Expenditure-12 -2023 dt:10-02-2023, the requisite Security Deposit can also be submitted in the form of "e-Bank Guarantee"
 3. Successful bidder should execute work agreement within 20 days from the date of issue of Letter of acceptance, failing which his tender will be cancelled & EMD will be forfeited.
 4. If the rate (s) quoted by Tenderer for any item (s) of work is / are above 125% of the estimated rates, then the amount over and above 125% will be withheld during the progress of work.
31. Security Deposit Will is released after the completion of the defect liability period.
32. Building and other construction workers welfare cess:

The contractor shall subscribe 1.00% of gross amount of each bill payable to him in respect of contract to the building and other construction workers welfare cess as per GO No: LD 300 LET 2006, Bangalore, dated: 18-01-2007. The amount of subscription will be recovered out of payable amount to him in each bill. This component is deemed to have been included in the quoted rate / Item rate.
33. Successful Bidder should submit the PERT Chart at the time of Execution of Agreement & should adhere to the accepted programme submitted by him under any circumstances without linking to the pending payment of the work.
36. Sub leasing / sub contracting in any form is prohibited. Bids of bidders with track record of Sub leasing / subcontracting are liable for rejection.
37. The intending bidders shall visit the site, identify the quarries, ascertain availability for the Quantity and quality of the materials required for the work and shall quote his rates accordingly. No extra claim whatsoever will be entertained in this regard.
38. The bidder should follow the instructions issued in the circular at 07-11-2023 of the mines & geology department regarding procurement of material from the licensed mines contractors. Any violation in this regard action will be taken as per the circular.

39. All precautions should be taken by the contractor so that there are no damages to such public/private properties & to avoid any damage to the utilities during excavation as well as utility shifting.
40. Contractor should follow strictly the prevailing rules of labour act.
41. Contractor should adhere to HSE (Health Safety Environment) policy applicable for similar projects.
42. Contractor to that extent should submit HSE document defining all the procedure including the policies before execution of the project.
43. Contractor should take all precautions to ensure that no damage is caused to the existing structures which have been constructed by other agencies during project execution. If any damage is caused it has to be rectified at his own risk and cost.
44. The intending bidders should inspect & get confirm regarding availability of materials and has to make own arrangements to get the construction materials. There are no extra claims will be entertained from Nigam.
45. Uploading of NSIC Certificate or Other certificate for relaxation of EMD Payment is not accepted as per government Order Dated 26.03.2019.
46. CNL reserves the right of rejecting all or any of the tenders without assigning any reasons.
47. Typo graphical errors if any will not be the ground for any claims by the contractor.
48. Tenders shall remain valid for a period not less than ninety days after the deadline date for Tender submission & earnest money deposit for the tender shall be valid for 45 days Beyond the validity of the tender.
49. The undersigned reserves the right to either postpone or to cancel the entire process of tender.
50. In the case of the death of the contractor after executing the agreement / commencement of the work, his legal heir, if is an eligible registered contractor and is willing can execute and complete the work at the accepted tender rates irrespective of the cost of the work.
51. Idle charges for men & machineries for non-progress period delayed due to any reasons will not be paid.
