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10. Any Contractor registered in appropriate class with Central Government/ State Government or their undertakings, any PSU in requisite class, or an agency of international or national repute may participate in the tender but registration with the Public Health Engineering Department, Bihar in requisite class will be essential after issue of LoA and before signing the agreement.
 11. The bidder shall submit his bid/tender on e-Procurement platform at www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in.
 12. The bidder must have the class I/II Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) with signing+ Encryption and user-id of the e-Procurement website before participating in the e-tendering process. The bidder may use their DSC if they already have. They can also take DSC from any of authorized agencies. For user-id they have to get registered themselves on e-procurement website www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in and submit their bids online on the same. The offline bids shall not be entertained by the tender inviting authority for the tenders published in e-procurement platform.
 13. The bidders shall submit their eligibility and qualification details, technical bid, financial bid etc, in the online standard formats given in e-procurement website at the respective stage only. The bidders shall upload the scanned copies of all the relevant certificates, documents etc, in support of their eligibility criteria/technical bids and other certificates/ documents in the e-procurement website. The bidder shall digitally sign on the supporting statements, documents, certificates uploaded by him, owing responsibility for their correctness/authenticity. The bidder shall attach all the required documents for the specific tender after uploading the same during the bid submission as per the tender notice and bid document.
 14. All the required documents should be attached at the proper place as mentioned in the e-forms otherwise the tender of the bidder may be rejected.
 15. Tender/BID Processing Fee (TPF) and the cost of BOQ/form fee to be paid through e-payment mode (i.e. NEFT/RTGS, Credit/Debit Card and Net Banking) only.
 16. The estimated cost may increase/decrease, though cost of tender document, bid processing fee and amount of earnest money will remain the same.
 17. For E.M.D. Payment only Bank Guarantee (in standard format) shall be accepted as offline instrument through e-proc 2.0 tender process; vide RCD letter No. 5651(E), Dated-19.08.2020; which shall be duly endorsed/Pledged to the Executive Engineer, P.H. Division, Hajipur. Bank Guarantee of nationalized/ scheduled Bank may be uploaded as offline instrument and shall be valid up to 225 days after the date of receipt of tender. The BG shall be issued on / after the start date of uploading bid document by the employer and refer/up to the stipulated last date of uploading the bid by the bidder, shall as be applicable.
- As per RCD letter no.163 (E) there is no need to physically submit the bank guarantee to the authority inviting the tender; however the successful bidder has to submit all the relevant documents in original before the agreement along with the BG.

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EMD Payment "Earnest money deposit (EMD) can be paid either through online mode through Internet payment gateway or Net banking.

Note: "Bids along with necessary online payments must be submitted through e-procurement portal www.eproc2.bihar.gov.in before the date and time specified in the NIT/RFP. The department/tendering authority don't take any responsibility for the delay/non submission of tender/non reconciliation of online payment caused due to non availability of internet connection, internet traffic/holiday or any other reason."

18. The tender opening will be done online only. Any corrigendum/addendum or date extension notice will be given on the e-procurement website only.
19. Detailed terms and conditions of tender will be enclosed along with the Bidding Document, and will be binding on the tenderer.
20. The bidders must qualify the technical eligibility criterion as laid out in the relevant sections of the ITB of the standard bidding document. Non conformance of these criteria will lead to non responsive bids.
21. The bidders must submit an affidavit separately with the bid document that they are not liable for disqualification as per clause 4.8 (Instruction to bidders: Section 1 General) of the Bid Document.
22. For rates quoted below the estimated cost, additional performance guarantee shall be deposited by the tenderer as per conditions of bid document and government circulars at the time of agreement.
23. The bidders are advised to visit work sites before submission of tender to study local site conditions, availability of labor and material etc.
24. The JV firms must ensure the criteria of JV as per clause 4.4 (Instruction to bidders: Section 1 General) of the Bid Document.
25. The undersigned has the right to extend, accept or reject the tender without assigning any reason thereof.
26. **No claim shall be entertained because of disruption of internet service being used by the bidders. Bidders are advised to upload their bids well in advance to avoid last minute technical snags.**
27. There is no ceiling/limit for going below the BOQ rate for percentage rate tenders as per RCD Letter No. 447 (S) and 449 (S) dt. 16.01.2020. The successful bidder shall submit additional Performance Guarantee as mentioned in the SBD.

As per the relevant clauses of the SBD and RCD letter no. 3987(s) dated 28.04.12, tenderers will have to declare by affidavit that they have not been declared defaulter or blacklisted by the State/Central/PSUs. If such affidavit is subsequently found to be false, their tender shall not be considered and further legal action shall be initiated.
31. As per the directions of Additional Chief Secretary, Dept. of Home, Govt. of Bihar vide letter no. 29 dt. 25.01.21, the successful bidder shall submit recent character certificate before execution of the agreement.
32. The bidders are required to submit a duly "Notarized affidavit" stating that there are **no outstanding electricity dues pending** for payment against all electric consumer numbers in their completed or ongoing operation & maintenance contracts.
- The affidavit shall be duly supported/ substantiated by a "no due certificate" that there are no outstanding electricity dues pending for payment against all electric consumer numbers in their completed or ongoing operation & maintenance contracts duly issued by the concerned Executive Engineer(s).

As per the relevant clause of the SBD and RCD letter no. प्र०७/नियम-०१-०३/२०२६ (खण्ड)-३१०३(s) dated 06.05.2026 paragraph 163A in civil works for which the tender amount is maximum of Rs. 50 Crore and less than Rs 25 Lakh preference will be given to the state level contractor/Tenderer (as define in Clause-B)
