NOTICE INVITING TENDER (NIT)**1.1. GENERAL**

1.1.1. Tinsukia division of Northeast Frontier Railway invites Open tender through E-tendering system in Single Packet System from eligible agencies who fulfill the Eligibility Criteria as stipulated in clause 1.2 of NIT for the work of “Construction of 100 KLD ETP waste water recycling plant on turnkey basis for reuse of discharge water of Mechanized Laundry, DBRG with operation and maintenance for 2 years at Dibrugarh Coaching Depot of Tinsukia Division”

The brief scope of the work is provided in Section III Special Conditions of Contract.

** Any firm recognized by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) as ‘Startups’ shall be exempted from payment of Earnest Money on submission of Registration Certificate issued by appropriate authority.*

1.2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

1.2.1 Technical Criteria:

The tenderer must have successfully completed or substantially completed any of the following during last 07 (seven) years, ending last day of month previous to the one in which tender is invited:

Three similar works each costing not less than the amount equal to 30% of advertised value of the tender, or

Two similar works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of advertised value of the tender, or

One similar work each costing not less than the amount equal to 60% of advertised value of the tender.

Similar nature work shall mean: As per Dy.CME/C&W for General Manager (M) L/No. Mech/C/Tender Corresp/Pt.IV/241,Dated 17.05.2021

“Supply, installation and commissioning of Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) or Sewage treatment Plant(STP) or Waste Water Recycling Plant of at least 50% of the capacity of the plant being tendered in Railways/Any Govt. Sector/PSUs”

Note:

Work experience certificate from private individual shall not be considered. However, in addition to work experience certificates issued by any Govt. Organisation, work experience certificate issued by Public listed company having average annual turnover of Rs 500 crore and above in last 3 financial years excluding the current financial year, listed on National Stock Exchange or Bombay Stock Exchange, incorporated/registered at least 5 years prior to the date of closing of tender, shall also be considered provided the work experience certificate has been issued by a person authorized by the Public listed company to issue such certificates.

In case tenderer submits work experience certificate issued by public listed company, the tenderer shall also submit along with work experience certificate, the relevant copy of work order, bill of quantities, bill wise details of payment received duly certified by Chartered Accountant, TDS certificates for all payments received and copy of final/last bill paid by company in support of above work experience certificate.

1.2.2 Financial Criteria:

The tenderer must have minimum average annual contractual turnover of V/N or ‘V’ whichever is less; where

V= Advertised value of the tender in crores of Rupees

N= Number of years prescribed for completion of work for which bids have been invited.

The average annual contractual turnover shall be calculated as an average of “total contractual payments” in the previous three financial years, as per the audited balance sheet. However, in case balance sheet of the previous year is yet to be prepared/ audited, the audited balance sheet of the fourth previous year shall be considered for calculating average annual contractual turnover.

The tenderers shall submit requisite information along with copies of Audited Balance Sheets duly certified by the Chartered Accountant/ Certificate from Chartered Accountant duly supported by Audited Balance Sheet.

1.3.1. The Tenderers may obtain further information/ clarification, if any, in respect of these tender documents from the office of Senior Divisional Mechanical Engineer, N. F. Railway. Tinsukia.

1.3.2. The intending tenderers must be registered on e-tendering portal: [http:// www.ireps.gov.in](http://www.ireps.gov.in). Those who are not registered on the e-tendering portal shall be required to get registered beforehand. After registration, the tenderer will get user id and password on login, tenderer can participate in bidding process and can witness various activities of the process.

1.3.3. The authorized signatory of intending tenderer, as per Power of Attorney (POA), must have valid class-II or class-III digital signature. The tender document can only be downloaded from e- tendering portal using class-II or class-III digital signature. However, the tenderer shall upload their tender on <https://www.ireps.gov.in> using class-II or class-III digital signature of the authorized signatory only.

1.3.4. Only online payment of Earnest Money Deposit shall be accepted.

1.3.5. Submission of Tenders shall be closed on e-tendering website of RAILWAY ADMINISTRATION at the date & time of submission prescribed in NIT after which no tender shall be accepted.

It shall be the responsibility of the tenderer to ensure that his bid is uploaded online on e-tendering website <https://www.ireps.gov.in> before the deadline of submission.

1.3.6 Tenders shall be valid for a period of 60 days (both days inclusive i.e. the date of submission of tenders and the last date of period of validity of the tender) from the latest Date of Submission of Tender and shall be accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit.

1.3.7. RAILWAY ADMINISTRATION reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals without assigning any reasons. No tenderer shall have any cause of action or claim against the RAILWAY ADMINISTRATION for rejection of his proposal.
