

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Name of work: Operation of Iron removal plants under jurisdiction of Sr. DEN/1/TSK for 2 years. (FKG-1, JTTN-1, JT Goods-1, MXN-1, NCH-1, SLX-1 & AGI-1 and KXL-1, GLGT-1, NMGY-1, BBGN-1, & BLMR)= 12 nos. & (SLGR-1, BOJ-1, MRHT-1 & SRTN and NAM-1, NHK-1, BFD & SPK)= 8 nos. (Total = 20 Nos.).

1.All staffs of IRP and valve operation must give Biometric attendance in the office mentioned as follows:(Location may be changed during the work as per requirement of Railways) & the whole Biometric arrangement to be provided by the agency. During the shift if any IRP/valve operator found absent, a penalty of Rs 10000 will be charged.

2. The filtration and supply of water should be strictly ensured by deputation of adequate resources as per the direction of Engineers representative at site. Non-compliance of the same will result in a penalty of Rs 10000/- to be imposed and will be recovered from the bills.
3. Overhauling of each iron removal plant shall be done once in a year and non-compliance of the same will be liable to penalty amounting to minimum Rs 10000/- per day (over the due date of overhauling) for each IRP and maximum as per the direction of Engineer or its representative at site.
4. The personals deputed in the operation shall wear proper uniform approved by Divisional Officer and shall be provided with Identity card. They should be provided with mobile phones to contact them which should always be operational during duty hours. Failure in this regard will result to a penalty amounting Rs 10000/- will be imposed.
5. One water test kit shall be made available at site always and daily testing of water and recording its test result in a daily record register shall be ensured.
6. Log book should be regularly maintained by the operator regarding material and testing details Testing to be done on regular basis Any irregularities in log book /record keeping will result in a penalty of Rs 5000/-.

8. Maintenance of IRP and its accessories viz. dosing pumps, valves, air compressors etc is the responsibility of the contractor and under no circumstances their breakdown should hamper the quality and supply of water. Failure in this regard will result to a penalty amounting Rs 10000/- will be imposed.
9. Sufficient quality of chemicals used in filtration process shall be kept available at the site and materials shall be passed by the competent authority prior to its use. If during visit any of the material is found NIL, a penalty of Rs 10000/- will be imposed.
10. For every water test results coming outside the prescribed limit, a penalty of Rs 10000/- for every failed test result shall be recovered from the contractor's running bill amount. Also, absence of contractor's staff from the IRPs and valve operation during the duty hours shall also result in imposing penalty upon the contractor as decided by Railway's Engineer .
11. The IRP should be kept clean .If during visit, the area of the IRP not found neat and clean, a penalty of Rs 10000/- will be imposed.
12. It will be responsibility of the contractor to conduct tests of residual chlorine, iron &PH value and record the same in registers. Tests to be conducted at source of supply & at two locations in colony/station. It should also within the farthest locations at least once in a month. A penalty of Rs 10000/- will be imposed for non-compliance of each test/or if test record in registers found not maintained properly.
13. On surprise check of residual chlorine and iron tests, if test results are not found within the permissible limits, minimum Rs 10000/- penalty for each failed test shall be imposed.
14. Water testing kits should be of standard brand and quality and the same shall be duly approved by Engineer or his representative. Test report of various materials supplied shall be submitted to engineer or its representative and after due approval of test report, material shall be supplied. Non-compliance of these instructions will result to suitable penalty upto Rs.10000/- .
15. All materials to be supplied at the nominated store by the concerned SSE/W & after materials passing materials to be used at site.
