

## SOUTH WESTERN RAILWAY

**REGULATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS****(For The Guidance of Engineers and Contractors for Signal & Telecommunication Works under Works Contracts)**

1. **The Indian Railway Standard General Conditions of Contract**, i.e., IRSGCC-2022 has been published in the month of April 2022. However, intending bidders are requested to acquaint themselves with all the conditions of IRSGCC- 2022 before participation in tender. Copy of IRSGCC- 2022 (with up-to-date correction slips) can be downloaded from the DOCUMENTS attached along with this tender.
2. Further, the following are supplementary instructions/conditions to the “Regulations for Tenders and Contracts” of IRSGCC 2022 Part-I.
3. **Availability of Bid Documents and Mode of submission:** The complete tender document is available online on website ireps.gov.in and the tenderer is expected to examine carefully all instructions, Standard General Conditions of contract, Special Conditions of Contract, relevant data, forms, terms, conditions and specifications, schedule of quantities, in the Tender Document.
4. The bidders should keep checking the website for any addenda/corrigenda to the notice/Tender documents till the date of online submission of bids, and the bidder should incorporate the same in his bid documents.
5. Bid(s) must be submitted online through the e-portal [www.ireps.gov.in](http://www.ireps.gov.in) before the time specified in Tender document (as per server clock). The department does not take any responsibility for the delay caused due to non-availability of internet connection or network traffic jam etc. for online bids.
6. Bid documents consisting of qualification information and eligibility criterion of bidders, the schedule of quantities of the various schedules of work to be done and the set of terms & conditions of tender to be complied with by the tenderer can be seen on website [www.ireps.gov.in](http://www.ireps.gov.in) and scanned copies of the requisite documents and information as per compliance and checklist should be attached with the Technical/Financial Bid as prescribed in the Tender document.
7. Bid for the Tenders will be closed on the date and time as specified in NIT and Technical Bids will be opened online thereafter. If the office happens to be closed on the date of closing tenders, the bids will be opened on the next working day.

9. In case of the documents uploaded, any overwriting or correction shall be attested by tenderer with initials. There should be no overwriting/cutting/corrections anywhere in the uploaded documents. The order of precedence of documents will be the same as given in IRSGCC 2022

10. **Interpretation:** These Regulations for Tenders and Contracts shall be read in conjunction with the IRSGCC 2022 which are referred to herein and shall be subject to modifications, additions or supersessions by special conditions of contract and/or drawings, manuals, specifications and/or special specifications, if any, annexed to the Tender Forms.

**11. TENDERERS CREDENTIALS:**

11.1. **Technical Eligibility Criteria:** As per IRSGCC 2022

**11.2.1. Signal:**

- a) EI/OC b) UFSBI c) SSBPAC(D) d) UFSBI Block Interface e) Datalogger/RTU  
f) HASDAC/SSDAC g) MSDAC h) Fire detection/suppression i) Electrical lifting barrier j) IPS.

**11.2.2. Telecom:**

- a) STM/SDH/IP-MPLS b) PD Mux c) ISDN/IP based Exchange d) CCTV / Video surveillance system e) ISS f) Networking equipment.

**Note:** SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT IN WORKS FOR ELECTRONIC INTERLOCKING:

As per Railway board letter no. 2013/Sig/23/01/(pt)Dup dated 17.02.2022 The successful bidder shall submit an undertaking from RDSO approved EI OEM, before the supply of material, to confirm compliance with extant RDSO guidelines and to meet contract specific requirements.

**NOTE:**

- (i). The Experience Certificates are to be attached to the e-offer as per **Proforma -1**.
- (ii). The Certificate to satisfy similar work should be signed by an officer not lower than JAG officer in Railways and Executive Engineer rank or equivalent grade in other department of Govt. of India/State Government/ PSUs of Government of India / State Undertaking. Tenderer shall attach Certificate copies along with the e-offer.
- (iii). For evaluating tenderers eligibility with regard to work experience, the tenderer shall furnish relevant certificates and details of the physically completed works.
- (iv). The total value of similar nature of work completed during the qualifying period, in terms of the final bill amount, and not the payments received within the qualifying period alone, will be considered. In case, the final bill of similar nature of work has not been passed and final measurements have not been recorded, the paid amount including statutory deduction is to be considered. If final measurements have been recorded and work has been

completed with negative variation, then also the paid amount including statutory deduction is to be considered. However, if final measurements have been recorded and work has been completed, with positive variation but variation has not been sanctioned, original agreement value or last sanctioned agreement value whichever is lower shall be considered for judging eligibility.

- (v). Work Experience Certificate issued by Central/State/Semi Government Organizations / Authorities, PSUs of Govt. of India / State Government shall only be considered.
- (vi). Certificates issued to tenderer as sub-contractor for sub-let Works by any Organization (Govt./ Pvt. Organizations) will not be considered.
- (vii). The decision of the Railway regarding the correctness/suitability of the Certificates is final and the tenderer shall not have any claim whatsoever in this regard.

**11.3. Financial Eligibility Criteria: As per IRSGCC 2022**

**11.4. BID CAPACITY:**

Bid Capacity shall be governed in terms of clause 10.3 of IRSGCC 2022. The Tender/Technical bid will be evaluated based on Bid Capacity formula detailed as Annexure-VI of IRSGCC 2022. The Bid Capacity is applicable for works costing more than **Rs. 10 Crores** and details regarding Bid Capacity shall be submitted along with the tender in **Proforma-2** duly verified and certified by the Chartered Accountant.

**19. Non-compliance with any of the conditions set forth hereinabove is liable to result in the tender being rejected.**

**(i). An offer shall become invalid:**

- (a). If the offer is not digitally signed by the tenderer / authorized person of the tenderer as per Tender conditions.
- (b). If any Individual / Proprietor Concern/Firm / Partnership Firm / Company / JV/ HUF/ Registered Society & Registered Trust uploads more than one offer either in his / their individual capacity or as a Proprietor or as a Partner / Member of Partnership Firm / JV / HUF / Registered Society& Registered Trust or as a Director of any Company etc.

**(ii). An offer shall get liable for rejection, if the tenderer adds any condition on his / their own (anywhere in the e-offer), which is in violation of the Railway's Tender Conditions.**

**(iii). An offer shall become ineligible for award of the tendered work if the tenderer does not fulfill the Eligibility Conditions i.e. Standard Financial Eligibility Criteria, Standard Technical Eligibility Criteria & Bid Capacity. It shall be mandatorily incumbent upon the tenderer to identify state and submit the supporting documents duly self-attested by which they/he are/is qualifying the Qualifying Criteria mentioned in the Tender Document.**
