A) List of Laboratories:

B) Special conditions of the work:

1. The material supplied conforms to latest Rly's specifications in all respect and should strictly be in accordance with the approved samples.
2. Loading, unloading / transportation charges etc. shall not be paid separately.
3. Such material will be approved by the Assistant Engineer shall only be accepted. The rejected material will have to be removed immediately from the site and in lieu another supply of the materials as per Rly's specification should be made immediately but not later than the date of completion of the contract agreement. No material will be loaded unless approved by the Engineer or his representatives.
4. The quantities of each item are approximate and may be increased or decreased accordingly to the needs of the Rly.
5. The monthly average supply as shown in the schedule of rates should be kept. When supply of ballast for a period is less than the quantity of supply per month for the period then penalty of **Rs. 10/- (Rupees Ten)** per cubic meter for less quantity of ballast will be imposed.
6. All work of supplying ballast, murum, sand of aforesaid and stacked for measurement will be taken only for these stacks that are levied and on sites that have been previously selected by the Engineer. Complete stacks only will be measurement made of uncompleted stacks.
7. Stacks less than 1 meter in height except for smaller quantities will not be accepted unless specially sanctioned in writing by the Engineer.

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8 The contractor will at the own expense obtain such permit or parwans for carrying or for any other purposes as may be necessary to enable him to perform his part of this contract. The president will not under any circumstances be liable to obtain any permit or parwana whatsoever.

9. The tenderer must carefully study the provision of the mines act on such of the quarries declared as Mines under the Mines Act, the contractor is responsible for implementing the provision under the Act at his own cost and the Rly will not be held responsible for infringement of the clause provided in the Mines Act.

10. In case the contractors have to deploy vehicles for purposes connected with the contract, adjacent to the Rly tracks the Railway Administration will have liberty to post an experienced staff as a flagmen for guidance of movements of such vehicles so as to prevent accident. The contractor will bear wages including all allowance etc. of the staff posted as flagmen, for such periods, during which such staff deployed for the purpose.

11. Ballast that is being supplied should conform to the Railway Specification for graded ballast, ballast not conforming to specification is liable to be rejected, if at the time of measurement of the stacks the sieve analysis the ballast do so not strictly conform to the specification but contains some oversized by the materials which however is suitable for P.Way adjusted by the Assistant Engineer such ballast can be taken over but the ballast will be paid for at a lower rate as decided by the Administration. The rate decided by the Administration will be final and binding on the contractor.

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
