Tenders in two parts are invited through e-procurement portal for “ **Electrification work of all instrumentation Rooms at downstream of Kadra Dam site**” from reputed bidders with proven track record of successful completion of similar maintenance works.

1.0 Instructions regarding (e-Procurement)

- The Bid has to be submitted in the Govt. of Karnataka e-procurement portal website only. i.e., <https://kppp.karnataka.gov.in>
- Bidders who have not registered in e-procurement portal, may do so by registering through website <https://kppp.karnataka.gov.in>
- Pre-qualified bidders can access the bid document on website, fill & submit the completed bid documents into electronic tender on website itself within stipulated date. Blank bid documents can be accessed through e-procurement portal website <https://kppp.karnataka.gov.in>
- Bidders shall attach scanned copies of all certificates pertaining to pre-qualification requirement as mentioned under minimum qualifying requirements clause. Whenever required, bidders shall furnish the original certificates to KPCL authorities, failing which the bidder will be disqualified.
- Conditional bids, incomplete bids, bids without EMD, bids not uploaded properly and late submission of bids shall be rejected.
- Bidders shall refrain from altering/modifying/revising the price bids after the date & time fixed for submission of bids in calendar of events, even though it is accepted by the portal. Date & time stamp of portal shall be final in deciding time & date of submission of bid. Decision of the Corporation in this regard is final and acceptable to all the bids.

2.0 EMD: EMD of **Rs.10,101/-/-** which should be paid online through e-portal using any of the modes as specified in e-Portal.

- Instruments having fixed validity issued as earnest money deposit for the tender shall be valid for 180 days beyond the validity of the tender.
- Any tender not accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) shall be rejected by the Employer as non-responsive.
- The EMD of the successful tenderer shall be returned after awarding the Contract on entire satisfaction of the KPCL, signing of contract agreement and upon submission of required Security Deposit. The EMDs of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned after signing of agreement and upon submission of Security Deposit by the successful bidder.
- The earnest money deposit shall not bear any interest.
- The earnest money deposit of the successful Tenderer shall be discharged when the Tenderer has signed the Agreement and furnished the required Performance Security or may be retained as security deposit on willingness of tenderer.

3.0 Tender Processing Fee

Payment towards Tender processing fee **(As per e-proc. portal)** can be made through Credit Card, Direct Debit, National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT), Over the Counter (OTC). Transaction fee is non-refundable.

4.0 Brief scope of work “**Electrification work of all instrumentation Rooms at downstream of Kadra Dam site**” Detailed scope is described in the Section-6 of tender document which are binding on all the bidders.

5.0 Pre-qualification requirements:

The bidders shall have the following pre-qualifying requirements:

- a) **Work experience:** The Bidder should have satisfactorily completed, as a prime contractor at least one similar works in any Power plant/ public sector/ Private sector undertakings of value not less than **₹ 2.02 Lakhs** in the preceding five years (i.e.,2021-22,2022-23,2023-24,2024-25 & 2025-26). In proof of this, the bidder should submit single Work orders and corresponding work done certificates issued by competent authority (in case of state/central Government/Government under taking from officers not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent cadre and in case of KPCL not below the rank of Chief Engineer). (A weightage of 10% per year is applicable to previous work/purchase orders to bring the current price level of 2026-27)
- b) **Qualification:** The bidder in his name, should have achieved an average annual financial turnover of **₹ 4.04 Lakhs** in at least any two financial years of the last five (i.e.,2021-22,2022-23,2023-24,2024-25 & 2025-26). In proof of this Turnover Certificate duly certified by Chartered Accountant shall be furnished. (A weightage of 10% per year is applicable to previous annual turnover to bring the current price level of 2026-27).

Other Statutory Documents:

- (a) Those bidders whose contracts have been terminated/fore-closed by KPCL or whose performance has not been satisfactory while executing the contract within last five years are not eligible to participate in the bid. The bidder shall furnish a an undertaking / notarized declaration in Rs.200/- Non-Judicial stamp paper as per in this regard. Failing which such bid will not be considered for evaluation
- (b) Labour/Establishment Registration certificate
- (c) Class-II and above Electrical contractor license.
- (d) Income tax PAN.
- (e) Independent PF code registration.
- (f) GSTN registration certificate.
- (g) ESI registration certificate.

Note: The original statutory documents shall be produced for verification at any stage of tender process as and when sought for, failing which, the bids are liable for disqualification.

6.0 The tender shall be submitted in TWO PART only (Two cover system)

- Part-I shall consist of pre-qualification, technical details, necessary documents & EMD.
- Part-II shall consist of financial bid.

7.0 The intending Bidders shall upload all the documents along with the tender.

8.0 After evaluation of technical bid, those offers which meet PQR & technical specification of the tender in complete manner will be accepted & financial bids of only such bidders will be opened.

10.0 Validity of Bid

The bid shall be valid for 180 days from the date of opening of Part-II (Financial bid) or extended period till the bids are evaluated and it is left to the discretion of NIT authority. The successful Tenderer shall deliver to the Employer a Security for an amount equivalent to 5% of the Contract price.

- 11.0** Bid with stipulation for settlement of disputes by reference to arbitration is not acceptable.
- 12.0** The prospective bidder should not coerce any other bidders to derail the healthy and competitive bidding process. Such acts entail the disqualification for participating in the tender process.
- 13.0** The prospective bidder shall not resort to anti-competitive practices like prices rigging, cartelization, ring formation/adopt unfair practices both civil and criminal aimed at preventing other bidders from quoting for the bid / any act inhibits competition / any act that will be detrimental to the interest of Karnataka Power Corporation Limited. If the bidder is found to have resorted to such practices as specified above, he and others who act in concert with him shall be debarred from quoting for this bid and future bids for a further period of three years.
- 14.0** KPCL reserves the right to verify any information/documents furnished by bidders, should the circumstances so warrant in overall interest of Corporation. In case, the information / documents furnished are found to be incorrect/ invalid, then, EMD furnished by such bidders will be forfeited.
- 15.0** KPCL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids, without assigning any reason thereof. However the reasons for rejection will be recorded as per KTPP Act.
